Our reason for being

RAEY was formed following a desperate plea by members of the Ethiopian community to Dr Carolyn Lee Roesler, seeking support and medical care.

Having committed a lifetime of work in orphanages and community groups, Dr Roesler had never witnessed such horrific conditions families were enduring on her first visit to Ethiopia. Many of the children she saw were sick and some had died from basic curable diseases that with adequate diet, sanitation and hygiene—would not exist. Parents with families to take care of were sick and dying from AIDS or other related diseases.

Families, unable to absorb the financial burden of trying to cure their diseases are forced to take drastic measures such as sending daughters as young as 8yrs, to domestic trade.

Living in complete and unimaginable poverty, the children and families of these communities live such a sad existence, denied of the most basic of needs. Without RAEYs **Care** and support, most go days without food and basic human needs. RAEY provides these **communities** with food, education, shelter and **hope**.
